Standard facilities for PC presentations will be available at the Symposium site.

POSTER PRESENTATION:

Poster presentations will be very welcome as well. Authors should submit the same information (including an abstract) as listed for oral presentations above by the same deadlines. The poster presentation session will be held on afternoon, **September 6**, **Friday**. However, all posters will be placed on the viewing boards <u>from the Friday morning</u> and will therefore be available for viewing during coffee breaks and lunch for the duration of the conference. A board (approximately 90 cm width, 160 cm height) will be available for posting each presentation.
