The 24<sup>th</sup> International SPACC (The Society of Pure and Applied Coordination Chemistry) Symposium will be held at The University of Auckland, New Zealand, from November 22 to November 25, 2017. The International Advisory and Organizing Committee cordially invite you to attend the symposium and participate in its scientific and social programs. The main theme of the symposium will be “Metal Complexes for Green and Sustainable Development.” The symposium will focus on greener processes using unique metal complexes and sustainable development toward new functional materials, as well as basic research on organic, inorganic, and biological chemistry for future inventions.

As with previous SPACC Symposia, it is intended that this Symposium will provide a platform for young scientists to exchange scientific information among themselves and with the selected leading scientists. It is our great pleasure to host this 24<sup>th</sup> Symposium in Auckland, New Zealand.

Presentations will consist of four categories – plenary lectures, invited lectures, oral presentations, and poster presentations. The International Advisory and Organizing Committee hope all registrants will present a paper, but acceptance of papers will be at the discretion of the Committee. The official language of the symposium will be English.

### **ORAL PRESENTATIONS:**

Abstracts should be prepared according to the Abstract Preparation Guidelines described below. Authors can download the abstract template from the website (<http://spacc.gr.jp> and [http://hartinger.blogs.auckland.ac.nz/spacc-24/scientific\\_programme](http://hartinger.blogs.auckland.ac.nz/spacc-24/scientific_programme)). The abstract should be sent via e-mail ([mikata@cc.nara-wu.ac.jp](mailto:mikata@cc.nara-wu.ac.jp)) to Yuji Mikata with “Presentation for SPACC24” as the subject, and “your name” as the file name. Only Acrobat PDF files will be accepted. The deadline for abstract submission is **July 31**. Authors will be informed within a week if their contribution has been accepted for a poster presentation rather than an oral presentation. Standard facilities for PC presentations will be available at the Symposium site.

### **POSTER PRESENTATION:**

Poster presentations will be very welcome as well. Authors should submit the same information (including an abstract) as listed for oral presentations above by the same deadlines. The poster presentation session will be held during the afternoon of Friday, **November 24**, 2017. However all posters will be placed on the viewing boards from Wednesday, November 22, 2017, morning and will therefore be available for viewing during coffee breaks and lunch for the duration of the conference. A poster space (approximately 90 cm wide, 160 cm high) will be available.

### **ABSTRACT PREPARATION GUIDELINES**

1. The abstract should be submitted in English, the official language of the symposium.
2. As the submitted abstract will be printed and reproduced directly without any editing, special care should be taken to ensure high quality of text and diagrams.
